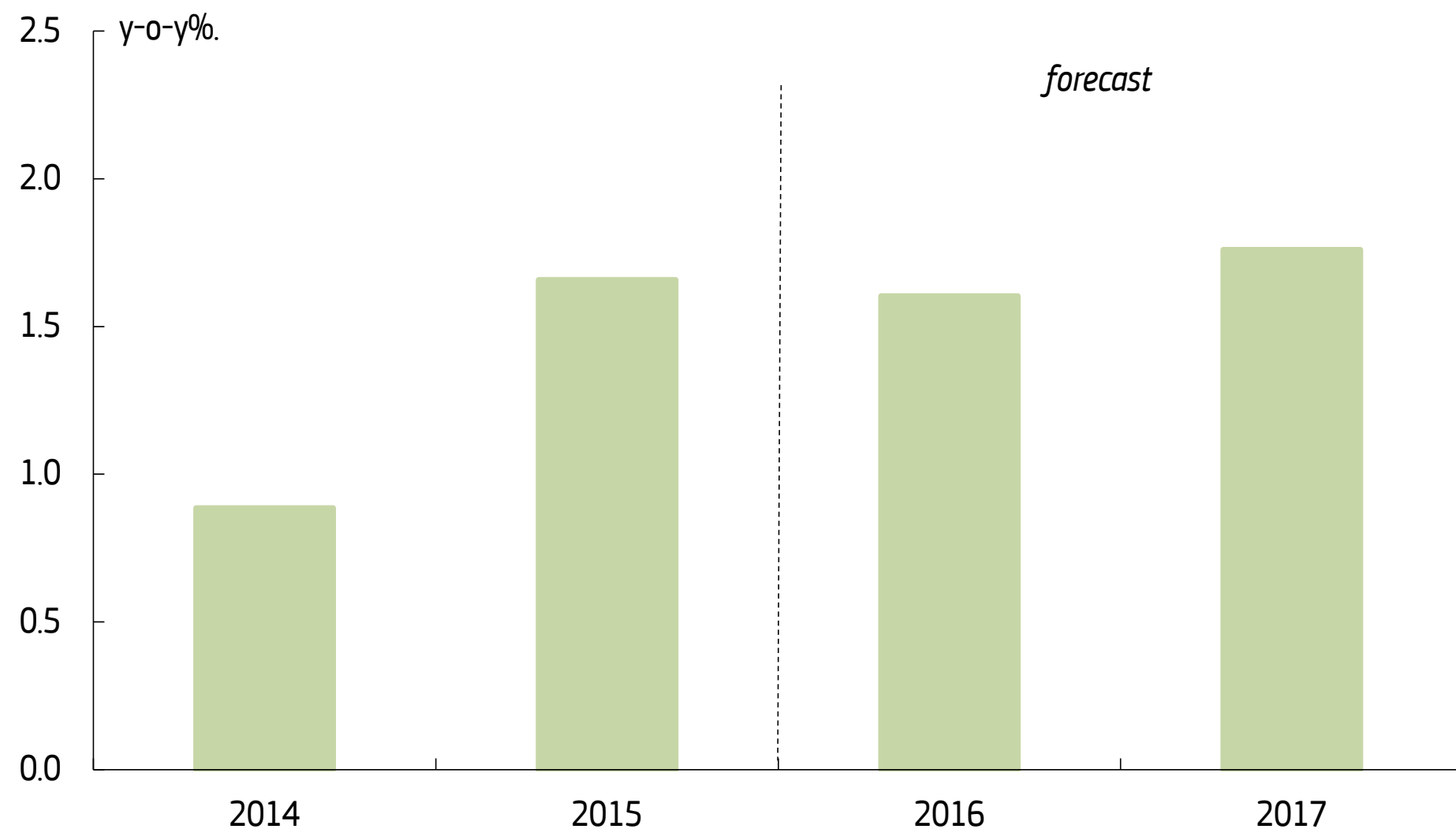

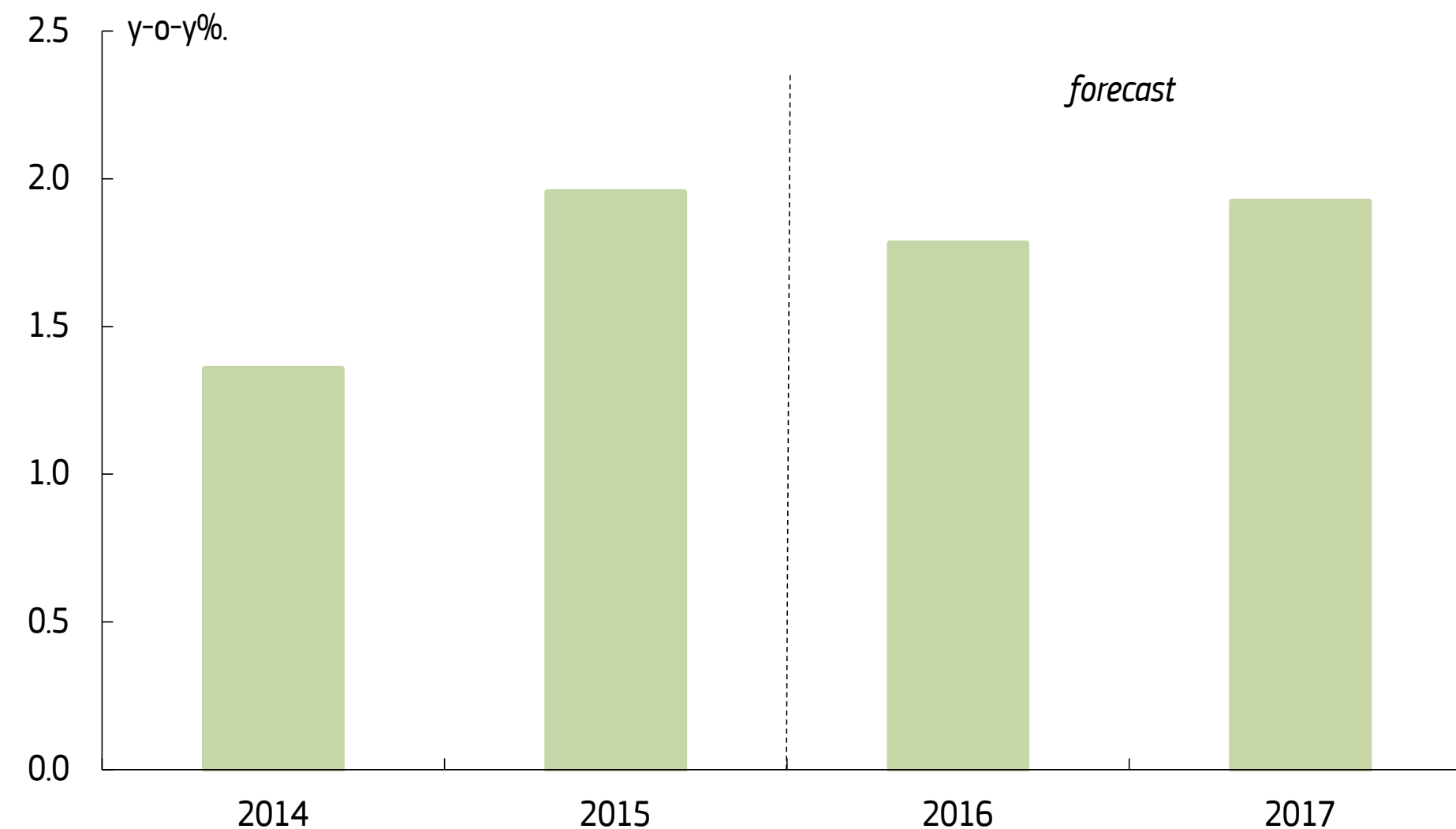

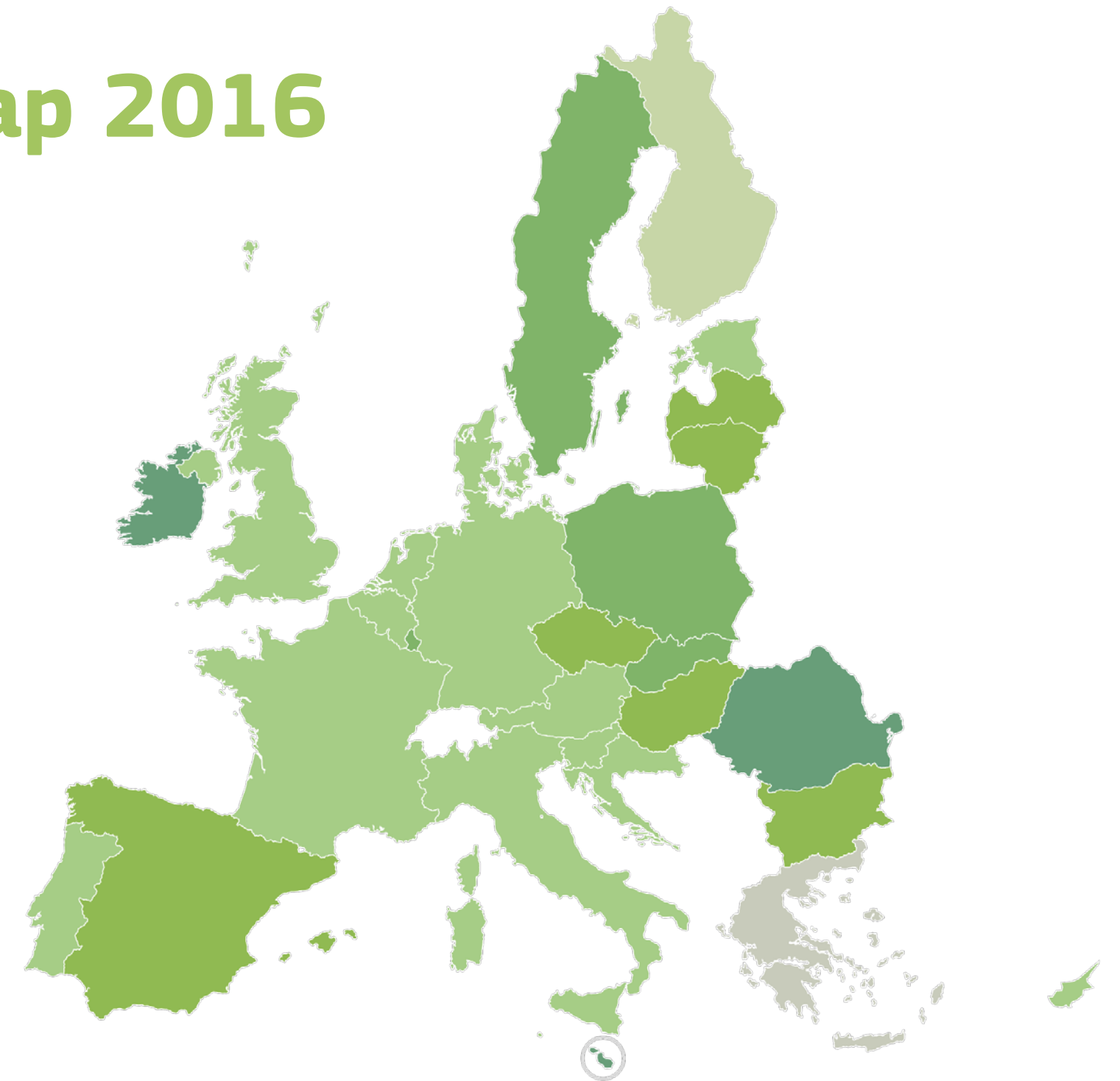
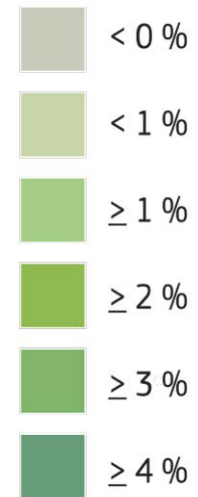

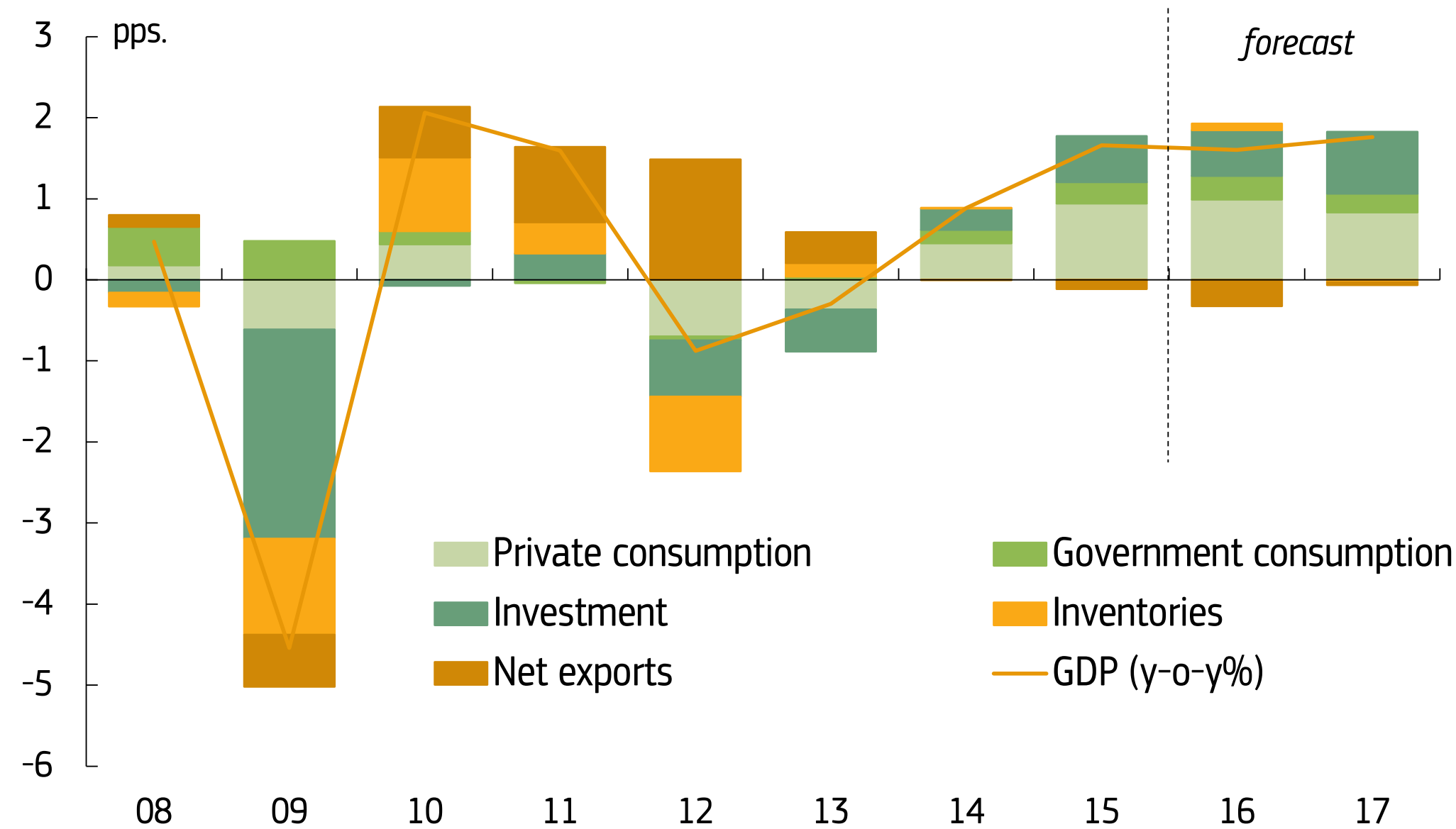

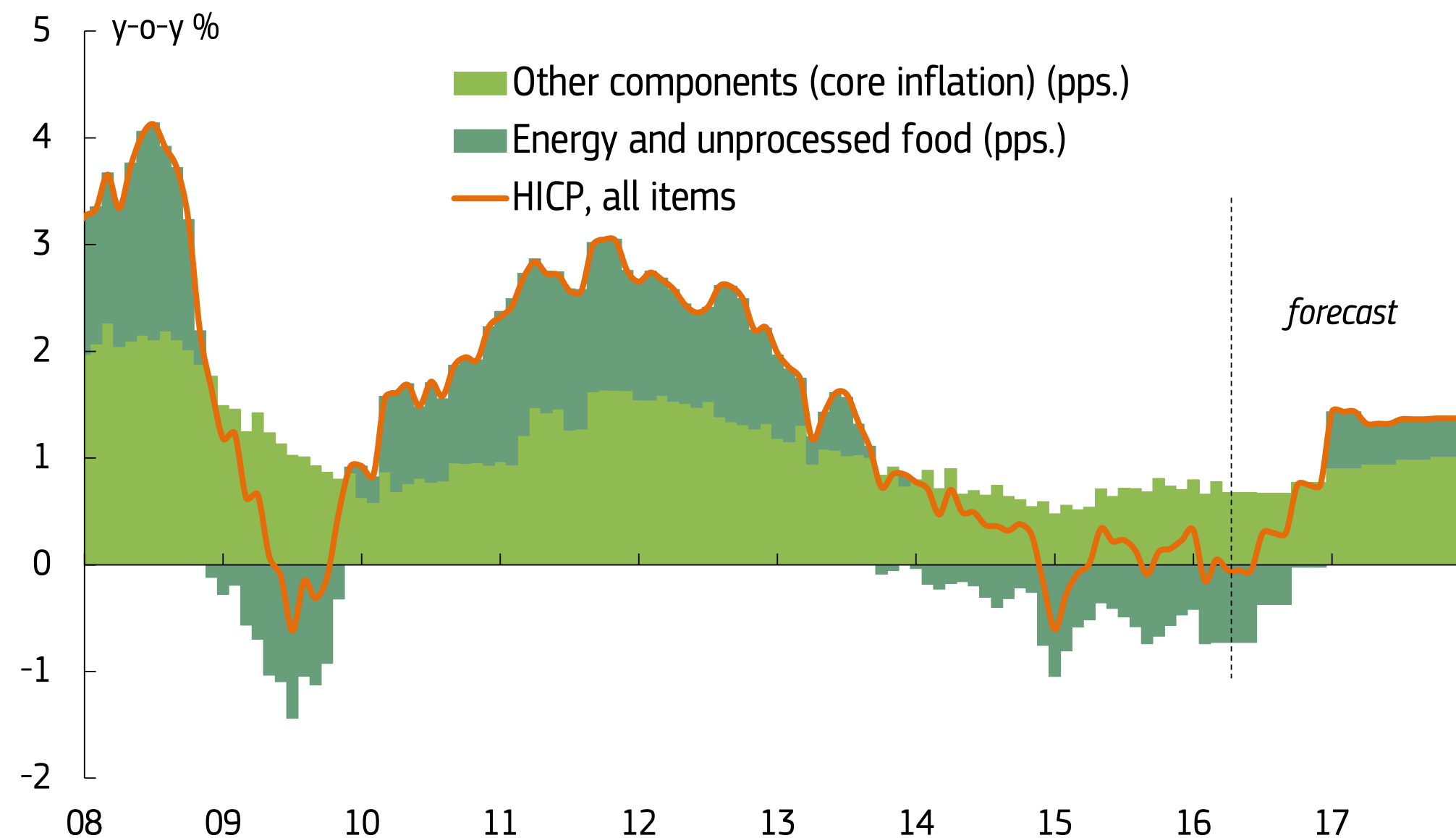


Private consumption driving growth, though losing momentum

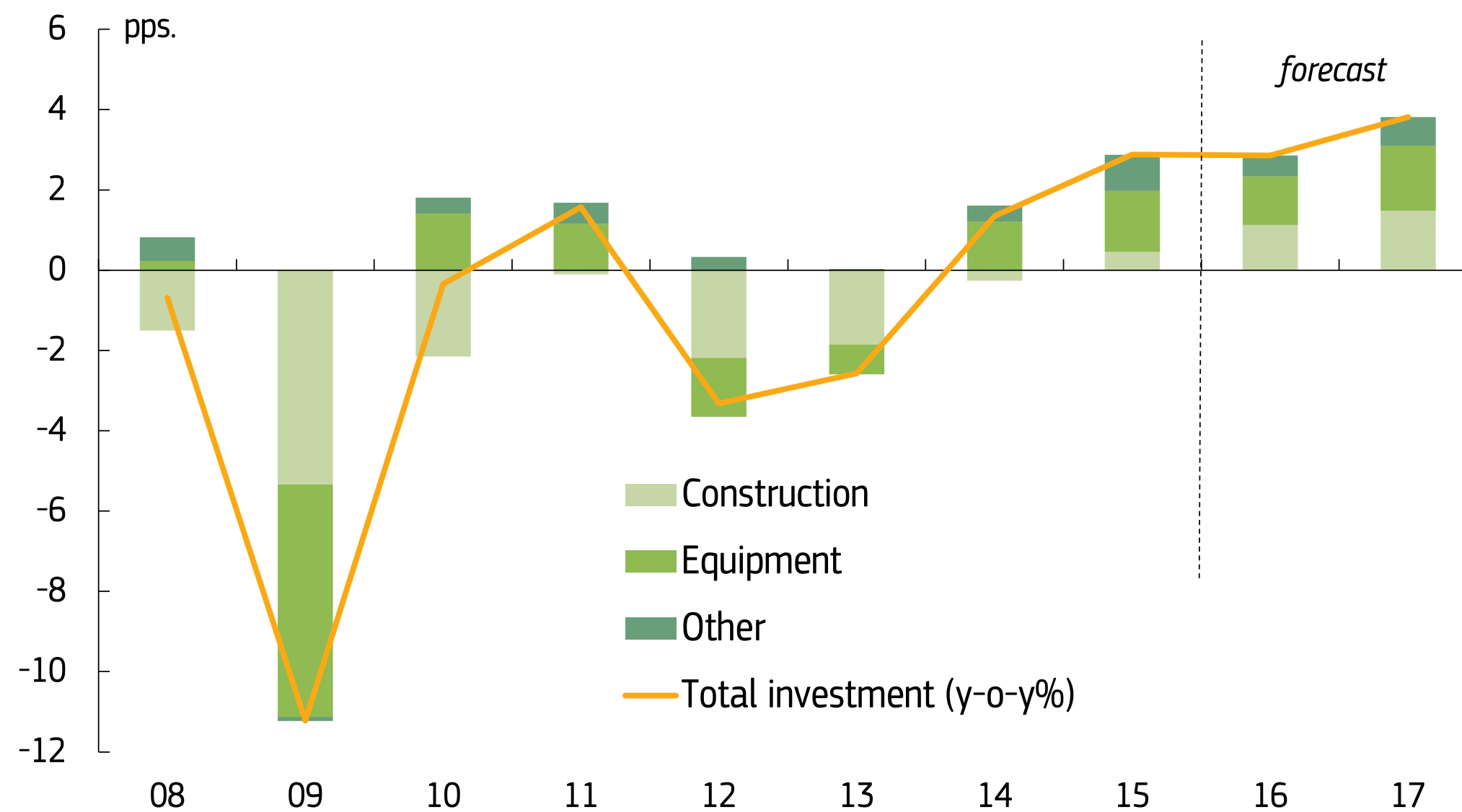


Inflation breakdown, EA

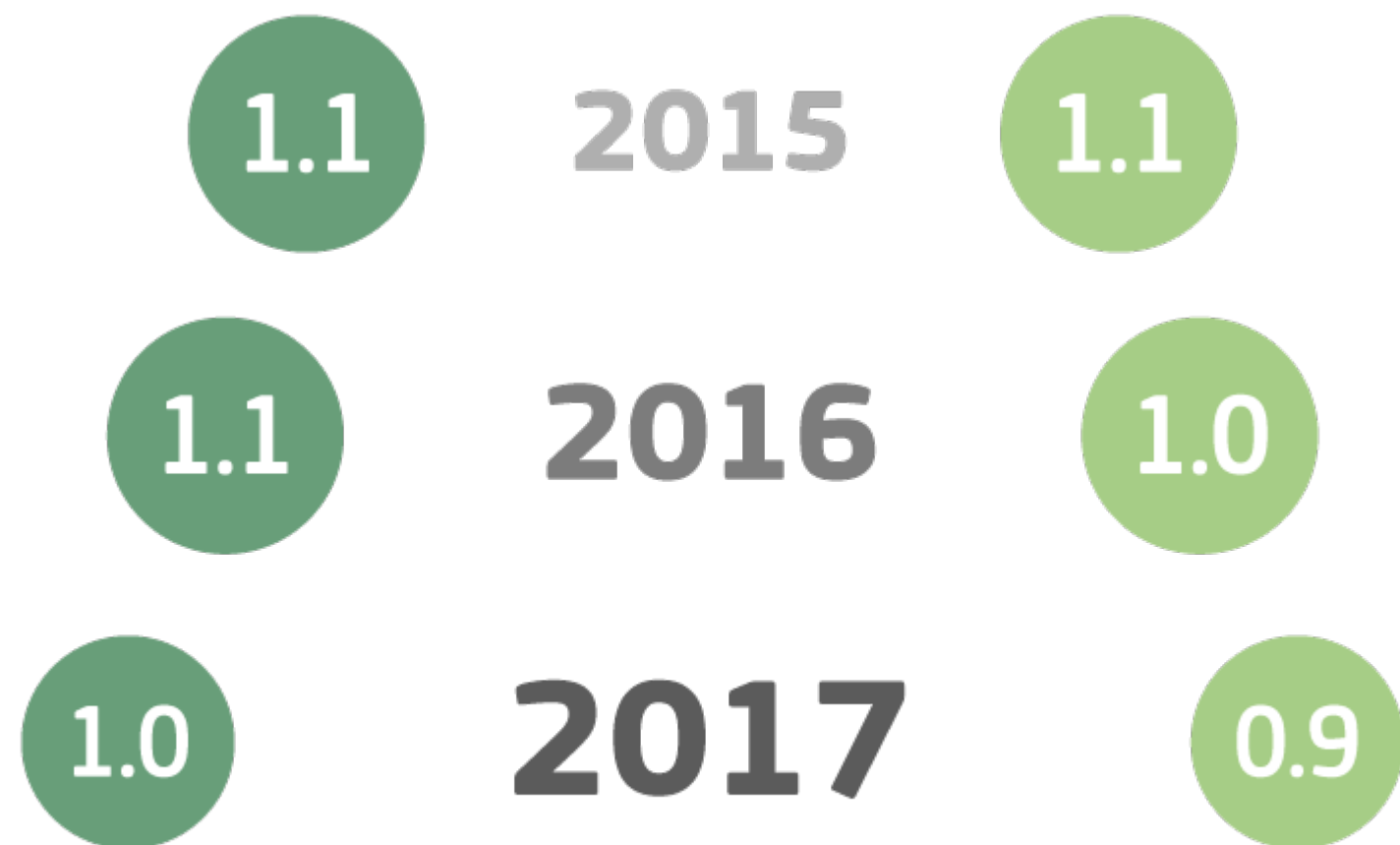

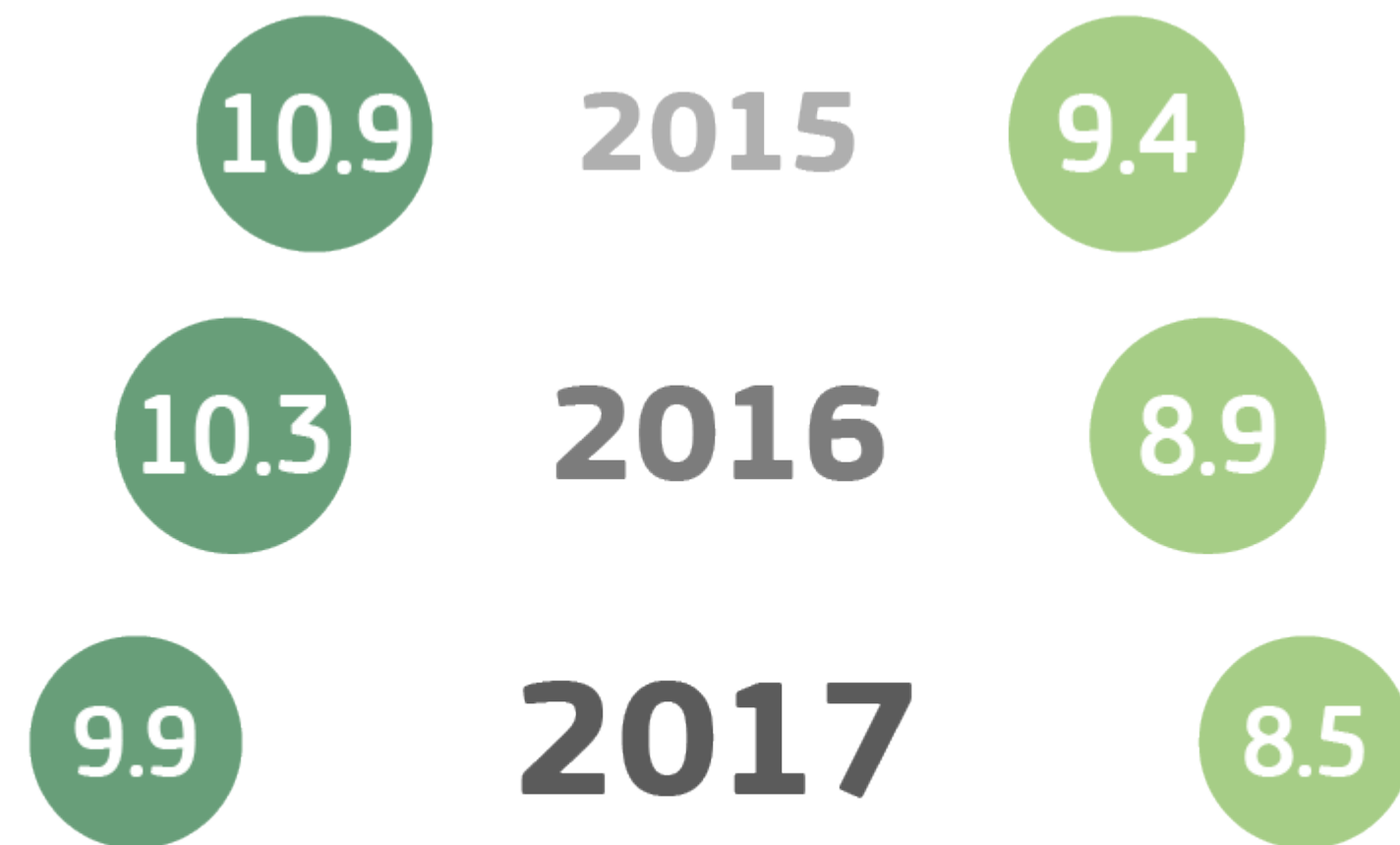

Median income: selected income groups, euro area



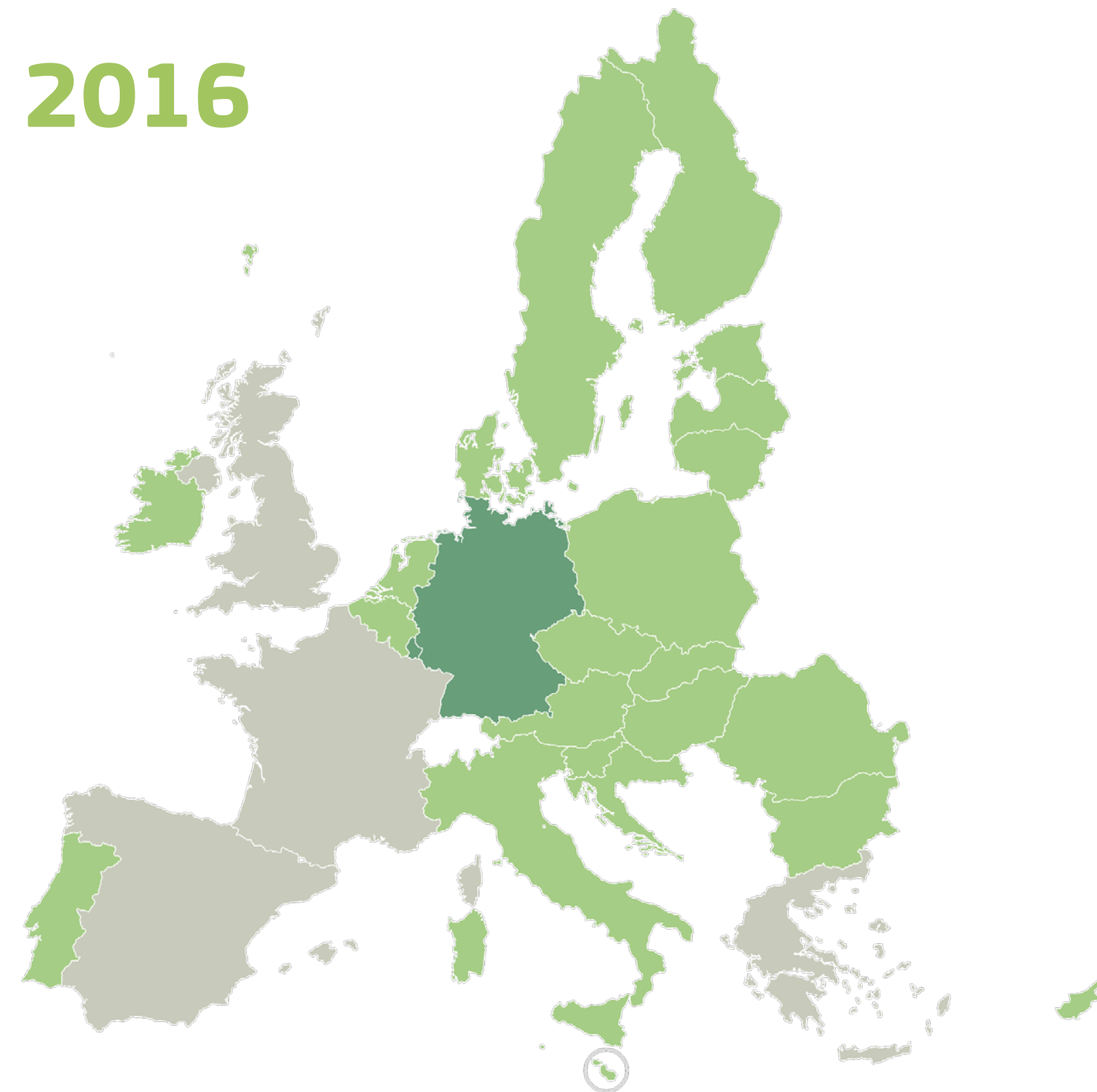
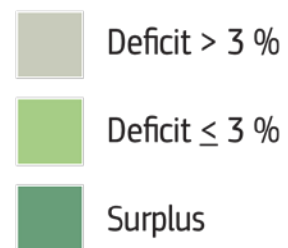

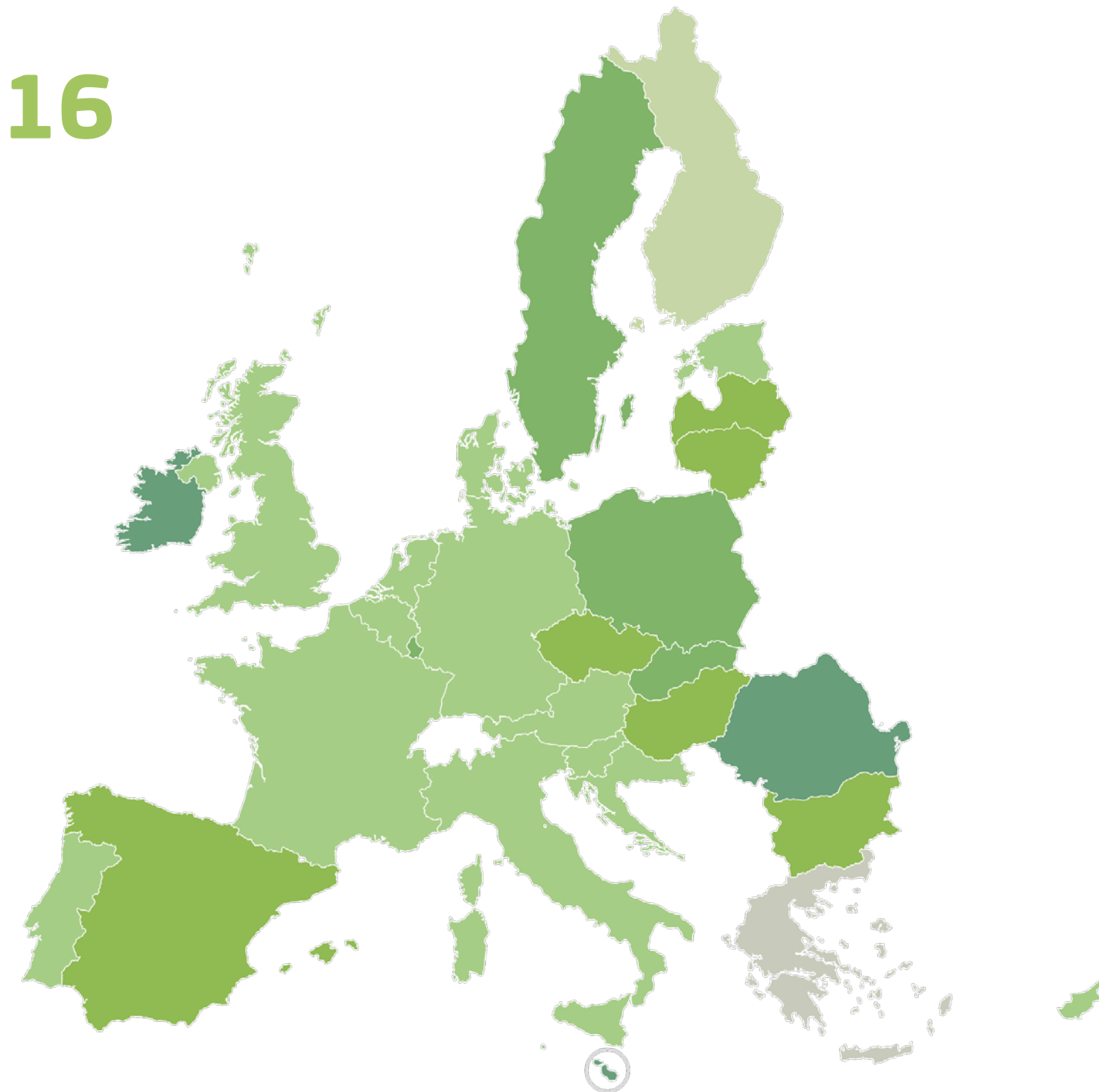
